## Karen A. Raffa Memorial Scholarship Information & Application



Karen Raffa was involved in the drum corps activity virtually her entire life. As a performer, she marched with St. Patrick's of Stoneham, MA, and later as an instructor with several Boston area corps. Her greatest role as running a drum corps event along with her husband Frank, The Beanpot, in the Boston area for more thank 35 years. She was devoted to making the event a class act. As a tribute to the quality of the show corps consistently asked to be in the show. Under their direction, proceeds, over \$150,000, have been donated to both members of the competing corps, local high school music majors and family members of the Cardinal Alumni Association. Karen tirelessly handled tickets, field arrangements, promotions and multitude of other tasks to ensure the event was successful.

The Karen A. Raffa Memorial Scholarship \$2000 award will be granted to a student enrolled in higher education while a participating member of a DCI participating drum corps in the 2024 season.

DCI will administrate the scholarship and has established the following guidelines:

- 1. The recipient must be enrolled full time in a college/university degree program.
- 2. The recipient must attend a college or university; not a trade school or vocational school.
- 3. The recipient must be an active marching member of a DCI participating drum corps that will compete in the 2024 DCI Summer Tour.
- 4. Each nominee must have their corps' director sign off as an endorser.
- 5. Scholarship(s) granted will be paid by check written to his/her drum corps OR college/university. Scholarship money may be used by the member to pay current or next season's corps tuition, university tuition, books other activity fees. Any unused scholarship monies, either from the student leaving the education establishment before completing his/her degree or upon the student completing and receiving his/her degree, OR by deciding not to continue in the drum corps activity, will be returned to DCI.
- 6. Scholarships granted will not be less than \$2000.00 per recipient.
- 7. The scholarship will be granted for one year only, but recipients may re-apply the next year if he/she remains active with a corps and meets all the other requirements.
- 8. Selections will be made by a committee consisting of individuals representing various DCI activities, the Cardinal Association and the Raffa family, whose decisions will be final.
- 9. The award will be announced on the Drum Corps International website in late May with other award recipients. Recipients should work with corps director to set up a meeting with the scholarship family/foundation at some point on tour and return a photo for posting at DCI World Championships in August.
- 10. Applications for 2024 Scholarships must be submitted to DCI via an email with ONE attachment (create ONE pdf of all required documents do not send multiple attachments) to Scholarships@DCI.org, NO LATER THAN MARCH 15, 2024. Please mark Karen Raffa Scholarship in the subject line. All required paperwork must be completed as a part of the Scholarship Application pdf.
